

How grateful I am to send this receipt letter of thankfulness for your gift to Fundamental Missions, Inc. for the month of July 2026. God richly bless you, dear supporters!

I have several things to report this month. The first is a sad report on Allen Smith in Liberia. Allen is in very poor physical condition. His lungs are diseased and perhaps he has heart failure as well. It is hard to get a medical diagnosis. His family says he can walk about 5 minutes before he is gasping for breath. Mostly he just lays on a cot hooked up to oxygen. Please pray for him. He has been a dear testimony to his fellow countrymen of salvation in the Lord Jesus. I believe his days on this earth are short. Liberia's medical treatment is quite primitive compared to America.

Last month I wrote about trouble receiving support checks. After 2 months, I finally received two checks. Now there are two sent in June which have not been received. This week a postal worker in Norfolk was convicted of stealing mail and selling it to a man who in turn cashed about \$150,000 of checks thus stolen. He is in custody. They were not stolen from my post office, but it seems this is not a closed case. So far, I know of no other missing checks. I still think the suggestions I gave last month would be helpful.

Now I ask prayer that the wires I send overseas would get through. I had great trouble with the last wire sent to Bro. Catbagan, but it did finally reach him. Bro. Rai did not receive his wire, however. He thinks his government is blocking such support. Please read his enclosed letter. We have been using these bank wires for many years with no trouble until now.

Now for some good news! The Booklet Maker from Jerry's print shop which I wrote about in April, has reached its destination in South America! It was detained at the port because the agent wanted too much money to release it. But praise God a more honest agent was found. Then it was delayed being delivered by truck due to roadblocks by dangerous men. This was a container filled with machines to print the gospel. The adversary is quite busy, but I am constantly reminded that "greater is HE that is in you, than he that is in the world." All glory to GOD!!!

Your love, prayers and support are so very precious to me. My own health is deteriorating more rapidly but how I praise God for the care of my physical family, as well as my spiritual family. When we get to Heaven, what a day of rejoicing that will be!
