SERMON NOTES

SERMON: Hebrews 9:15-28 | The Blood That Secures Salvation

MAIN IDEA: Jesus is the mediator of a new covenant whose unrepeatable sacrifice _____ those called to salvation from sin and secures their eternal inheritance.

1. **The _____: without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins. (vv.15-22)**
2. **The _____: Jesus appeared once for all to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself. (vv.23-26)**
3. **The _____: Jesus will appear a second time to save those who eagerly await Him. (vv.27-28)**

Adjust: In Christ, you have access to God's _____, _____ with God, and _____ for your life.

Application Questions:

1. Verse 22 teaches, "without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness." In today's culture, sin is often downplayed or rationalized. How does the vivid reality of blood sacrifices in the Old Testament—and Christ's ultimate sacrifice—deepen your sense of how seriously God views sin?
2. While Christ's sacrifice cleanses us eternally, we still stumble daily. When you recognize sin in your life, do you tend to hide from God out of guilt, or do you run to Him for cleansing? What holds you back from immediate repentance?
3. Unlike earthly priests who had to offer sacrifices year after year, Jesus did it "once for all." In what areas of your life do you try to "earn" God's favor or make up for your mistakes through your own good works? How does Christ's finished work free you from this cycle?
4. Verse 28 promises that Christ will appear a second time to bring salvation to those who are "eagerly waiting for him." Take a moment to honestly reflect: Are you truly longing for Christ's return, or are you more focused on building your earthly life? How might your perspective and priorities shift if you lived each day with a greater expectancy for His return?
