



Quiet Time Questions from August 09, 2026

Sermon in a Sentence: Genesis 50 shows us Joseph understood the heart, plans, and perspective of God.

Verse for Memorization and Meditation: *"But Joseph said to them, 'Don't be afraid. Am I in the place of God? 20 You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives.'" (Genesis 50:19-20)*

1. Read Genesis 50:1, Luke 19:41-42, Luke 15, and John 11:35. Joseph had a heart like God's. Can the same be the same for us? Do we weep over the things that cause God to weep? Do we rejoice over what causes all of heaven to rejoice?

2. Read Genesis 50:2-11 and Genesis 15:13-16. Joseph understood and desired the plans of God. Can the same be said of us? Do we spend time with God on a daily basis so we can understand His plans? Do we desire and trust the plans of God more than our own plans?

3. Read Genesis 50:12-26 and Romans 8:28. List the problems you are currently facing. Are you able to see your pain from God's perspective? Do you trust that God will use it ultimately for your good and for His glory? Are you able to let go of the pain others have caused you, forgive them, and turn them over to the Lord?
