Report for June–August 2026

Dear Pastor and Church, please accept our warm greetings. We are deeply moved by the natural phenomena occurring across the globe; the Lord is near. This encourages us, knowing we hold a blessed hope—something people without Christ need to know.

I am deeply grateful for your prayer and financial support; it enables us to do more for the expansion of the Lord's Kingdom and meets our needs.

Here is my report:

On May 29 and 30, we held a youth conference at our church. There were separate sessions for young women and young men, along with challenging preaching each night. God moved in a special way; dozens of decisions were made, and 110 young people attended.

Our hospital evangelism ministry continues. Amidst the pain and sorrow felt by family members, it is a prime opportunity to offer compassion and, above all, to show them that there is forgiveness and salvation in Christ.

We continue to witness from house to house; people have been saved, and we have welcomed visitors.

This July, on Friday the 24th and Saturday the 25th, we simultaneously held Bible clubs in four areas of the city, concluding with a great event on Sunday the 26th; people were saved.

We also held a baptism service.

Our young people participated in the Youth Camp in Bacalar from August 3 to 6, led by Pastor Franky Canche. God was at work; several came to the altar to surrender their lives to the Lord—specifically young women Vicky and Rebeca, and a young man named Elías. They approached me on Sunday the 9th for prayer regarding their decision to serve and to prepare for ministry at the Bible Institute. Glory to the Lord.

We have made progress on the classroom roofing. Installing the roof remains our greatest challenge, both in terms of labor and finances; we are praying that God will provide for this need. The cost to install the roof is \$8,000. So far, two churches have pledged their support: Pastor Roel García from Great Bend, Kansas, with \$800, and Pastor Macriano Cayetano from Hutchinson, Kansas, with \$600.

Thank you very much for your prayerful and financial support; it is a great blessing to us.
