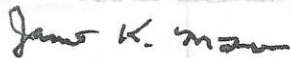
Mail service continues to be a problem, so if you do not receive receipt in a timely manner, please call me at 757-559-8960.

Dear Ma'am Janet and praying friends,

Warm Christian greetings in the precious and most worthy name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

We thank God for His continued goodness, grace, and faithfulness throughout the month of May. As we look back upon the many opportunities the Lord has given us, our hearts are filled with gratitude. We are especially thankful for your faithful prayers, encouragement, and support for the ministry. Your partnership in the work of the Lord has been a great blessing to us. We would especially appreciate your continued prayers for us as we are not getting any younger, yet the Lord continues to open doors for the preaching of His Word and for the furtherance of the Gospel. Though the passing years bring physical challenges, we are grateful that the Lord continues to grant strength, safety, and opportunities to serve Him. We remain humbled that He still allows us to have a small part in His work.

On May 1, 2026, my wife and I traveled to Ampusongan, Bakun, Benguet, accompanied by our son, Bro. Arbie, who drove us throughout the trip. We were invited by Harvest Bible Baptist Church, formerly pastored by the late Pastor Domingo Lachongan, to be part of their Revival Night on May 2 and their Church Anniversary Celebration on May 3. By God's grace, I was given the privilege of preaching His Word during both occasions. We thank the Lord for His protection and safety as we traveled through the mountainous roads of Benguet. It was a great encouragement to fellowship with the brethren and witness their faithfulness in continuing the work of the Lord. Despite various challenges, their love for God and commitment to the ministry remain evident. We are grateful for the opportunity the Lord provided to share His Word and to be a small part of encouraging and strengthening His people. They carefully evaluated the available classrooms and facilities and provided valuable recommendations. We informed them that we are prayerfully considering opening the Elementary Department not this coming school year but, Lord willing, the following school year. They encouraged us to begin preparing the necessary classrooms, facilities, and other requirements. They also advised that our teachers and staff undergo the required Christian Educators' Training. As part of this preparation, the teachers and staff of Lighthouse Preschool are scheduled to attend a week-long training at Grace Christian Academy in Baguio City from May 25–29, 2026. We humbly ask for your prayers for this endeavor, that the Lord would grant wisdom in planning, provide the needed resources, and guide us according to His will as we seek to expand this ministry for His glory.

Another great blessing this month was the Annual Moving-Up Ceremony of Lighthouse Preschool held on May 12, 2026. By God's grace, eighty-six pupils successfully completed their respective levels and moved up to the next stage of learning. We thank the Lord for the privilege of helping educate and influence these young lives not only academically but also spiritually. We are grateful for the dedication of our teachers, staff, and parents who worked together throughout the school year. It was a joyful occasion as we witnessed the progress of the children and recognized God's faithfulness in sustaining the school ministry. Thank you for your prayers and support, which continue to make this ministry possible.

On May 15, we once again traveled to Guinaoang, Mankayan, Benguet, to attend the Lighthouse Baptist Mission Anniversary and Church Organization. By the grace of God, the mission celebrated its 20th Anniversary on May 17, 2026, during the morning service. It was a blessed time of thanksgiving as we reflected on the Lord's faithfulness over the past twenty years in sustaining and blessing the ministry. The services were attended by several pastors, missionaries, deacons, and fellow laborers from various Lighthouse ministries, as well as visitors from other Baptist churches. By God's grace, I was given the opportunity to preach God's Word during these special occasions. We praise the Lord for His goodness and for the faithful efforts of many servants whom He has used through the years. It is a great encouragement to witness another church being established and strengthened to continue proclaiming the Gospel and serving the Lord in that community.
