I returned to Tanzania mid-July and will be returning back to the States at the end of September. The kids have started school already. Esther is in 11th grade, Benjamin is in 2nd grade, Rachel is in K-5, and Sarah is in K-4. We are so thankful that they have the opportunity to attend a Christian school.

The ministry here in Tanzania is truly thriving, and we are so thankful that the Lord continues to bless. We had our first Pastors' School. We brought in all the pastors and their wives and one deacon from our village churches for a two-day conference. It was a great time of teaching and learning but also a wonderful time of encouraging one another in the Lord. They even stayed the weekend and celebrated with us at Grace Baptist Church for our 12th Anniversary. Looking back at where we started to where we are now, I am humbled at what we have been able to do with God's help. We are looking forward to the next 12 years and seeing God's blessings continue. That day, we had over 800 in attendance, with 41 souls trusting in Christ. We also had a wedding, along with our traditional eating on the grounds.



A few deacons and faithful men went with me to Kenya, as I was invited to do a traditional Masai wedding. Our friend John, who is a Masai and was saved out of that traditional way, started a KJV Bible-believing church in his hometown for his own people. What a great work he has there, and the influence that he has on his own people is truly a blessing from God. While we were there, we also had the privileged to preach and help out with some financial needs they had. It is exciting to see God's hand working in other countries. Sometimes we get so focused on ourselves and ministry, we forget that God's hand is working in other places as well.



Thank you all again so much for your prayers and financial support. Thank you for the cards, texts, emails, etc. Your encouragement to us is so special. Please continue to pray for Martha. The cancer numbers are slowly increasing, so they have changed some of her pills. It will take some time to see if we have the right combination, so please pray that we can get those stable soon. She feels great and has wonderful energy, so that's why the numbers are surprising. We just continue to trust God, and we are grateful for each day.
