Tomorrow (Friday) we will have Rami and Milán over to our house again. She is bringing her boyfriend Matyi with her. Please pray that God would bless that time with them and give opportunity for spiritual conversation.

I signed a preliminary contract this week on a house we can buy. It is closer to several of the Christian friends we work with here, and has a nice yard with it, too. We are praying for the mortgage to go through. It shouldn't be a problem, since we had a loan previously for our house in Nyíregyháza, but you never know.

I am in the process right now as well of applying again for a residency card. They did away with the category we were using. Several countries in Europe are doing this right now, presumably to cut down on foreign money being funneled into their political system. We are using our volunteer contract with the high school as the basis for our residency now. We appreciate your prayers for that.
