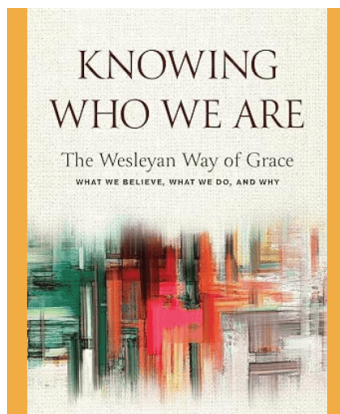
Matthew 9:9-13

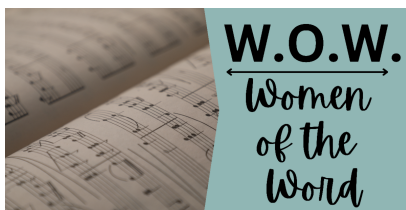

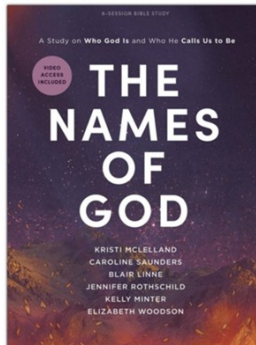

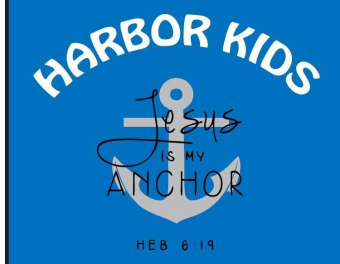
