A message from Pastor Shalimar Holderly

"Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also"
— Matthew 6:21

Money affects your heart. Whether you are in plenty or in want, money has a direct connection to your stress level, your anxiety, and the health of your relationships. It is no wonder, then, that Jesus talked about the relationship between our treasure and our hearts.

For a four-week period in September and October, we will look at the many ways that our treasure (time, energy, money) affects our spiritual and emotional lives in our new sermon series called *Treasure* which will begin on September 20th. We will explore Matthew 6 and Jesus' teachings on money, giving, worry, and more.

On Sunday, October 4th we will welcome Manet Shettle as our guest preacher. Manet is the President of the Heartland Methodist Foundation and the Heartland Methodist Financial. She will bring a message on Matthew 6:1-6, "Giving Your Treasure Back to God." She will also be joining us during the Sunday school hour where she will give a presentation and answer questions about the ministry of HMF. Some of our endowment monies are invested with the Foundation and we have received grants from them in the past (and hopefully in the future!). In addition to offering loans to churches, the Financial offers investment opportunities to individual church members through various types of certificates that benefit you as an individual while also benefiting the Church. I encourage you to plan to join us, not only for worship that morning, but for Manet's presentation during the Sunday school hour.

At the end of the four weeks, we will have an opportunity to make personal commitments of our offerings to God through our church in the coming year. We will receive commitment cards in the mail and cards will be available on Sunday morning. We are encouraged

Pastor's Assistance Fund and Kroger Gift Cards Report

Our congregation continues to bless members of our local community through the Pastor's Assistance Fund. Thus far this year we have assisted 43 households with rent/utilities and other billed expenses for a total of \$5,463. We have also distributed 23 \$50 Kroger Gift Cards for a total of \$1,150. Members of the community who find themselves in a place of need are eligible to receive one gift from the assistance fund which is paid directly to the company they owe and one Kroger gift card per 12-month period. Less than 10% of those receiving assistance this year received assistance in the previous 12-month period. Thanks to the Women's Circle and a few generous members of the congregation, we have replenished our Kroger Gift Card supply and now have a stockpile of 11 gift cards ready for distribution; however, our Pastor's Assistance Fund is running very low with a balance of \$87 as of August 27th. Until we receive more funds, we will be unable to offer assistance.

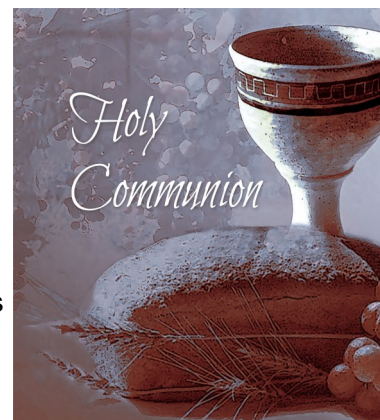

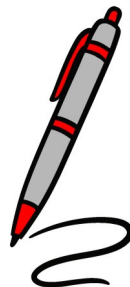
