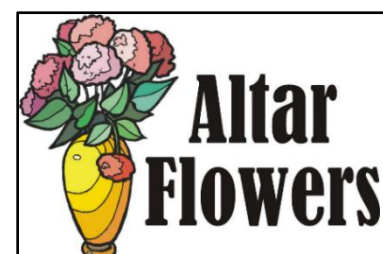
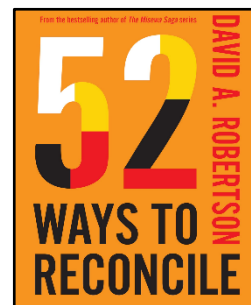
Morning Coffee Group in the Fireside Lounge

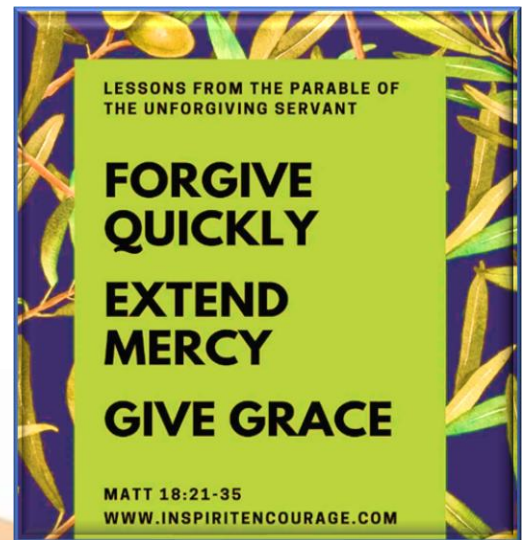

As the new school year begins, we pray for all of the children returning to the classroom.

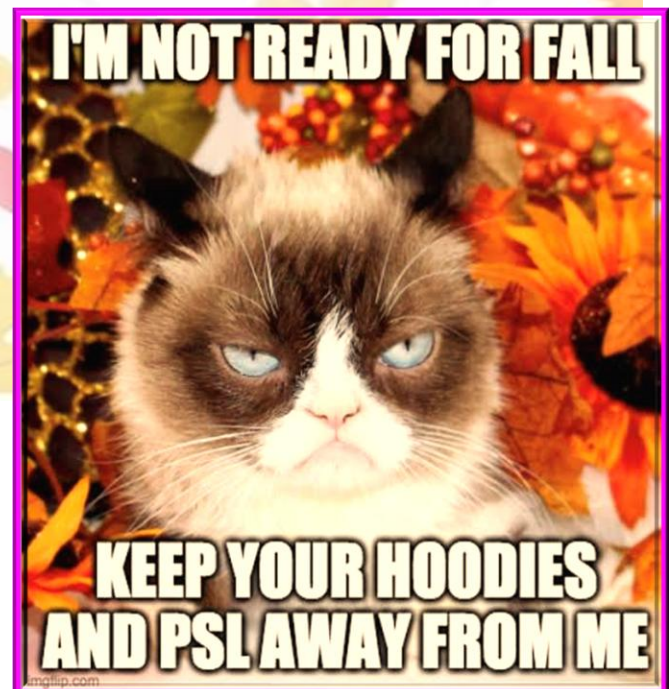
Grant them wisdom to learn and grow. Give them success in their studies, encourage them when they struggle, and surround them with kindness.
