I would like to thank you all for your prayers as I went through the process of obtaining my South African driver's license. To say that it has been a challenge would be an understatement. At the end of last year, I had attempted 3 times to take my exam. In August I was finally able to try again, but the day I went a riot broke out at the traffic department at the exact time that my test was scheduled. Finally, this past week, I was able to complete the test and **PASS**. God had a reason for each obstacle, and I just want to say thank you to each person who made praying a priority.

Solid Rock Baptist Church

In July, we had our Holiday Bible Club at church, it was Western themed. We had a great time with the kids teaching them Bible stories and seeing them excited to learn verses. We ended the week with an all-day Teen Rally with teens from several local churches. It was a great week. Please pray specifically for our teens, we have noticed over the last few months that many of them have stopped coming. The pull of the world is strong especially once they hit a certain age. We are gearing up for a Baptismal service in September where several are signed up to get baptized. We are excited as people are making this public testimony showing their commitment to the Lord.

Medical Ministry

In August, I had the opportunity to be part of a Health Educational Seminar and Health Screening at a local church on the effects of High Blood pressure, High cholesterol, and Diabetes. Then along with several ladies from our church, I screened for these complications. We had one young lady who had a major health problem discovered. The next week when I arrived back at the church to volunteer at the pregnancy center, I was greeted with "you saved that young lady's life". I found out that she had a heart condition that needed immediate treatment and if she had not come to the screening and been sent to hospital for further evaluation, it may not have been discovered. **God is good.**

I have had the opportunity to be a part of the crisis pregnancy center now for a few months, and God is showing me that there is such a need here in Gqeberha. There are at least 12 private abortion clinics, not including the government hospitals and clinics in our city and **only one place offering support and counsel for alternatives to abortion**. Please pray with me as I seek the Lord's will regarding what He would have me to do at our church.

Thanks to your donations, I had the opportunity to teach 6 caregivers at a local boy's home, CPR and first aid. This home houses 30 boys who have been orphaned or abandoned and none of the caregivers had ever gone through the training. It was such a privilege to be able to offer them this course. It was such a thrill to teach, and they were so excited to have the opportunity to be able to know what to do in an emergency situation. Through supporters, the Lord has provided funds for me to teach a total of 80 students. I have the funds to teach 6 more students. If any one is interested in donating towards the sponsorship of this course you can send donations through my mission board, Daystar Baptist Missions (contact at the Bottom) and designate it to: **CPR COURSE**. **The class costs for each student are approximately \$35.00 (this includes the book and mask).** Medical ministry comes in all shapes and sizes here, from putting on a band aid (or "plaster" as it is called here) or helping out with a major health situations. A couple of weeks ago, I had the opportunity to be used in a major trauma. I was driving on the interstate here and came upon a taxi accident. A taxi had run into the back end of a semi-truck. There were between 15-17 people involved in the accident. It was quite the scene and people were screaming, many broken bones, a partially amputated leg and I was the only medical personnel available. I praise the Lord that no one was killed in this accident and that I had a well-equipped first aid kit in my car to be able to help as many people as possible until the ambulance crews arrived about 15 minutes later. It was scary, but that night, I lay in bed and thought back on the experience about how scared they were and how I may have touched their wounds, but there are so many people who just like them still need Jesus and I was only one person. I was the only one trying to reach so many in desperate need of help, but I was not able to help all those in need. I felt the need so strongly of more labourers to reach people with the Gospel. **"The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few." Matthew 9:37.**

PRAYER NEEDS:

- **VISA:** I still await any response concerning my visa. Please pray that this is approved for three more years.
- **Language Study:** I continue to study Xhosa every day, it is exhausting, but the Lord is improving my understanding. Speaking is the challenge.
