



THE WAY

Acts 8:1-25

Read Acts 8:1-25 as a group. What stands out to you in this passage? What catches your attention, surprises you, or raises questions for you?

What do you notice about how different people respond to what is happening throughout this passage? What might their responses reveal about them?

What do you learn about God from what happens in this passage? Where do you see Him at work, including in circumstances that initially seem difficult or destructive?

Philip goes to Samaria and later Peter and John join what God is doing there. What do you notice about who is receiving the good news and how the church responds? What might this show us about God's heart for people?

Simon seems eager to be part of what is happening, but Peter identifies something deeper going on in his heart. What do you notice about Simon's response to Jesus and the work of the Holy Spirit? Where might we be tempted to approach God in similar ways?

Where has God placed you right now? What might it look like to join what He is already doing there? Where might you be tempted to choose comfort or hold back? Where might God be inviting you to “lean in”?

After spending time in this passage, what is one way you want to respond to what God is showing you? What would “leaning in” to Jesus look like for you this week in a concrete, ordinary way? How can the group pray for you as you do that?
