***Teaching Task of the Church - “1952”**

Leader: Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

People: Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path.

Leader: To the Jews who had believed him, Jesus said, “If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. 32 Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.”

People: Teach me your way, LORD, that I may rely on your faithfulness; give me an undivided heart, that I may fear your name.

Leader: Now there was a Pharisee, a man named Nicodemus who was a member of the Jewish ruling council. 2 He came to Jesus at night and said, “Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher who has come from God. For no one could perform the signs you are doing if God were not with him.”

People: It is written in the Prophets: ‘They will all be taught by God.’ [a] Everyone who has heard the Father and learned from him comes to me.

Leader: You, however, must teach what is appropriate to sound doctrine.

People: He is the one we proclaim, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone fully mature in Christ.

Leader: Again, if the trumpet does not sound a clear call, who will get ready for battle?

People: So it is with you. Unless you speak intelligible words with your tongue, how will anyone know what you are saying? You will just be speaking into the air.

Leader: And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever.

People: Many peoples will come and say, “Come, let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the temple of the God of Jacob. He will teach us his ways, so that we may walk in his paths.” The law will go out from Zion, the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.
