FIGHTING GLOBAL POVERTY

A pastor in Kenya will travel near the border with Sudan to bring rice, flour, and beans to villages suffering from drought and famine. Traveling with him will be farmers bringing healthy, drought-resistant seeds and showing villagers how to adapt and manage their lands under new climate conditions. These farmers will also encourage the five new churches that have been started to share the love of Christ in their villages and surrounding areas. Together, they will make several visits to continually provide support and discover ways these communities can lift themselves out of extreme poverty and into greater self-sufficiency.

It is encouraging to know that gifts from the Alma Hunt Offering are used for community development projects that alleviate poverty in Virginia and across the globe. This approach brings communities together to identify concerns, set priorities, and establish sustainable, long-term solutions while local leaders take ownership of the work. We are supporting ministries in Guatemala, Kenya, Ghana, Liberia, Romania, and Virginia, where lives are being changed economically, socially, and spiritually. People are being introduced to Christ, discipled, and churches are being started as practical help is shared through the lens of Christ.
