Stewardship of Our Witness - A Witness the World Cannot Deny
(Acts 4:1-14)

In Acts 4, Peter and John found themselves standing before the religious authorities because they had preached “through Jesus the resurrection from the dead.”

The Sadducees, who denied the resurrection and lived for earthly power, were troubled by this message. Yet even prison and intimidation could not silence the truth: Jesus Christ had risen, and His power had changed a life.

The healed man standing beside the apostles became undeniable evidence of the gospel’s power. The council could debate theology, question authority, and threaten the messengers, but they could not explain away a transformed life.

Peter’s answer was simple and bold: the miracle had been done in the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom God raised from the dead. That same witness is still needed today. In a world often focused on material things, arguments, and human achievement, the church is called to point people to two living testimonies: the risen Savior and the changed life. The Christian faith is not merely theory; it is the real work of God in real people.

May our lives speak clearly of the One who saves, heals, forgives, and gives eternal hope. Like Peter and John, let us

be faithful witnesses to Jesus and the resurrection—not only with our words, but with lives transformed by His grace.

Who in your life needs to see the reality of Christ through your words and your changed life?
