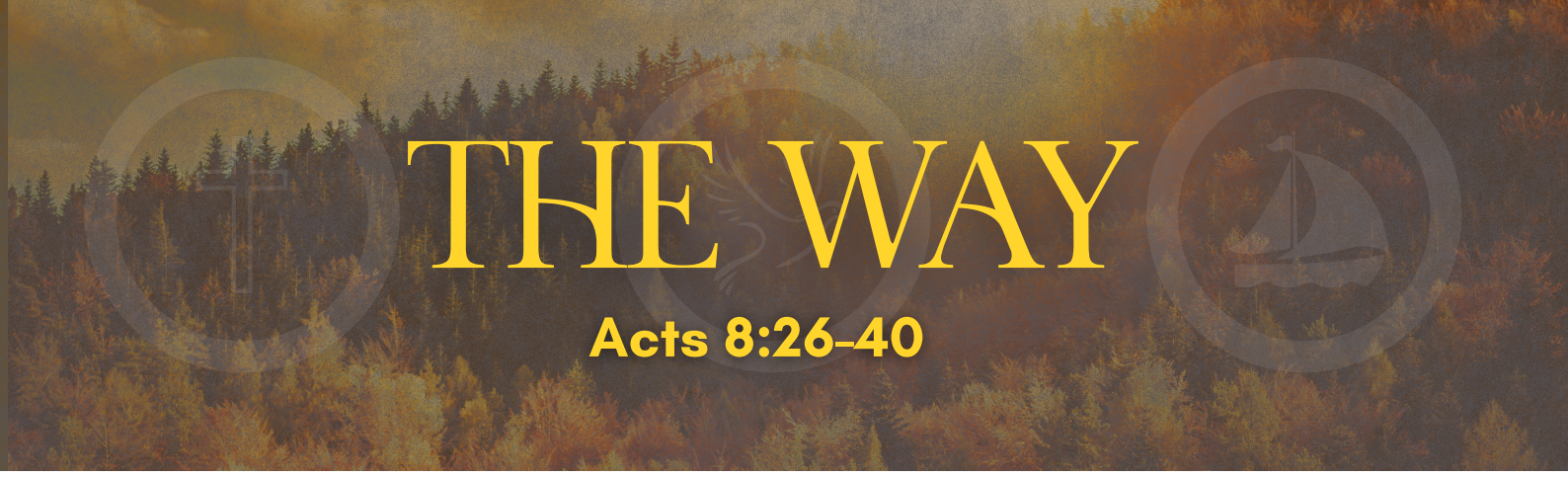




THE WAY

Acts 8:26-40

Read Acts 8:26-40 as a group. What stands out to you in this passage? What catches your attention, surprises you, or raises questions for you?

What do you notice about Philip throughout this passage? Pay attention to what God asks of him, what Philip does, and what he doesn't know along the way.

What do you notice about the Ethiopian man's posture toward God? What can we learn from the questions he asks and the way he responds?

What does this passage show you about God and the ways He is at work in people's lives?

Philip is given one step at a time. First, “Go to the road,” and later, “Go to that chariot.” How do you tend to respond when you sense God inviting you to something but you can't see where it will lead?

What makes it difficult for you to recognize or pay attention to God's voice in your ordinary life? What helps you become more attentive to Him?

Where might God already be at work around you that you could easily miss because you're busy, distracted, uncomfortable, or simply not expecting Him? Is there something you have sensed God nudging you toward that you haven't acted on yet? What might be holding you back?

What could it look like for you to create enough quiet in your life to become more attentive to God? How can the group pray for you as you do that?
