

Revelation is the last book of the Bible. Many believe Revelation is a very difficult book to understand. Many also believe it is really scary and is something they want to avoid. So #TargetPractice: What is the purpose of the book of Revelation?

Because of that, Christ followers have a hope of a wonderful future with no pain, tears, sickness, or troubles in the future. If we can stay faithful to God, we will spend eternity with Him...and it will be worth it!!!
