Introduction of Bro. Abraham Melendez

MINISTRY SERVICE IN COSTA RICA AND PANAMA

Dear pastors, churches, and friends in Christ:

We would like to introduce Bro. Alex Abraham Melendez, son of Pastor Alex Melendez of Iglesia Bautista La Resurreccion in San Rafael Abajo, San Jose, Costa Rica. Although many of you have not yet had the opportunity to meet him personally, we can testify that he is a faithful man of God, committed to the work of the Lord and willing to serve wherever God has opened doors.

In Costa Rica, he is an active member of Iglesia Bautista La Resurreccion and serves as the pastor's assistant. His ministry includes preaching the Word of God, working with the young people, picking up people so they can attend church services, evangelizing the lost, and helping bring children and families to church. The church does not have buses, so this work is done with the personal vehicles of the brethren, using whichever vehicle is available at the time. These responsibilities are part of his service to the local church and his desire to reach others with the Gospel.

At present, Bro. Abraham also works a secular job to meet his responsibilities and needs. For that reason, it is important to clarify that he is not currently supported as a full-time worker. Even so, he continues to give his time and effort to the ministry, seeking to faithfully fulfill both his secular work and the opportunities for service the Lord has given him.

He also makes trips every two weeks to Puente Blanco, Panama, where Iglesia Bautista La Resurreccion helps minister in an indigenous community. Depending on the situation or need, some trips are made weekly. There he serves children, adults, and families alongside believers from Costa Rica and Panama. With the support of brethren from both countries, the work has continued to move forward. God has provided a church building, pews, and a place where His Word can be preached and the Gospel shared.

Bro. Abraham's desire is to one day devote himself full-time to the work of God. He longs to have more time to preach, evangelize, serve the young people, help with the transportation ministry, reach children and families, and continue serving the ministry opportunities in Panama. At this time, he does not have the monthly financial support needed to leave his secular job and devote himself completely to the ministry.

While the Lord provides, he continues working and serving faithfully. We share this information openly so that churches may understand his present situation, know his heart for the ministry, and pray for him specifically.

Prayer and Support for Bro. Abraham

AN OPPORTUNITY TO HELP HIM SERVE FULL-TIME

How can churches and brethren help?

First, we ask you to pray that the Lord will continue to guide, strengthen, and use Bro. Abraham. Please also pray that God will raise up churches and brethren who would like to support him monthly. Steady support would allow him, as the Lord provides, to leave his secular job and devote himself fully to preaching, evangelism, and the other ministry responsibilities God has placed before him.

Although many still do not know him personally, we can testify that he is a man of God who loves the work and desires to serve faithfully. If a church or brother feels led of the Lord to take part in his support, that help will be a tremendous blessing and encouragement. Each church and each person can prayerfully consider this need and respond as the Lord leads.

Bro. Abraham has not yet been able to travel to the United States to present his ministry because he does not currently have a U.S. visa. If the Lord permits, he hopes to apply for it next year at the United States Embassy in Costa Rica. Please pray that his visa will be approved and that, in God's time, he will be able to enter the United States without difficulty and visit churches to personally present the work.
