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"Music...a vital part of a balanced spiritual diet"

I love music! Whether we love it or not, music impacts our lives. I am sure that many, if not all of us have a favourite song. Many have a song that evokes an emotion or marks an occasion. What is your favourite song? Did your mom tell you that she sang to you before you were born? Did your dad sing to you when you were young?

Music is a gift from God. In the bible, music is essential. Using music, people expressed praise and worship, as well as grief and lament. In fact, King Saul sent for young David who played for him, and the spirits fled and Saul's heart was lifted.

For sure, music is splashed all over the Psalms. Psalm 19 reminds us that the creation praises God – “declaring the glory of God.” In Psalm 40, the Psalmist cries out to God from the pit and expresses the joy of being heard, lifted out, and re-established by God. Most Psalms have been set to music. The psalms express worship through joy, pain, suffering, exultation, praise, contemplation, prayer and meditation. Over the years, many people of faith have taken time to set the sacred psalms to music. We are the beneficiaries of the faithful work of these people.

Common to the previous references is the response of praise for what God has done. When we become aware of God and what He has done and what He is doing in us, we are changed. This knowledge brings us to sing His praise.

When you sing, do you think about the words you are singing or does the beat and rhythm carry you? Have you ever sung when you were praying? There is something special in singing to the Lord. Music seems to touch the human heart and soul very deeply. God inhabits the praise of His people.

So, I encourage you to sing! Sing to the Lord. When you sing to Him, think about what you are saying. If you believe that you have nothing to sing about, sing anyway! God will meet you and, if necessary, will change your tune and give you a new song to sing to Him!
