Come help us create a place where kids can have fun, build friendships and know they belong.

Peace Mennonite Church (Richmond) is looking for a creative and energetic Kids Activity Leader to help us provide fun, welcoming spaces for children at our Community Meals and monthly Breakfast Church.

This is not a traditional Sunday School role. We're looking for someone who loves kids and can create fun, engaging spaces where they can play, create, connect, and belong.

About Us

We are a neighbourhood congregation in Richmond with a heart for Jesus and a deep love for our community.

Our twice-monthly Community Meals and monthly Breakfast Church bring together people from our church and wider community—including lots of kids! We're looking for someone to help us create a space especially for them.

During our **Community Meals**, the focus is primarily on providing a fun and engaging activity for children while their families enjoy the gathering.

At **Breakfast Church**, there is more opportunity for stories, conversation, creative activities, and simple faith-based teaching moments.

Kids' activities would generally run for approximately **30–45 minutes per gathering**.

The Role

As our Kids Activity Leader, you'll bring creativity, energy, and your own ideas to developing activities that kids enjoy—games, crafts, music, stories, group activities, and more.

Most importantly, you'll help create an environment where children feel safe, seen, welcomed, included, and valued.

This could be a great fit for a student, teacher, stay-at-home parent, childcare worker, camp or recreation leader, children's ministry volunteer, or anyone who loves working with kids and is looking for a small, meaningful part-time role.

Key Responsibilities

- Plan and lead fun, age-appropriate activities during Community Meals and Breakfast Church.
- Include simple faith-based stories or teaching moments where appropriate, particularly at Breakfast Church.
- Create a safe, welcoming, and inclusive environment where children feel known and valued.
- Build positive relationships with children and their families.
- Coordinate activity supplies, volunteers, and a small program budget.

Want a Few More Hours? — Optional Extra

If you're interested in additional hours, there is also an opportunity to lead a small Sunday morning program for preschool and early elementary-aged children. The emphasis would be on creating a warm and engaging experience through play, stories, activities, and age-appropriate faith formation. This is optional and is not a requirement of the core position.

We're Looking for Someone Who Is

- A committed Christian with an active faith.
- Warm, creative, energetic, and comfortable engaging groups of kids.
- Passionate about working with children and families.
- Highly Relational and comfortable in a diverse community environment.
- Experienced in working with children (church, camps, recreation, childcare, etc.).
- Reliable, organized, and able to take initiative.
- Able to work collaboratively with staff and volunteers.
- Willing to complete a Criminal Record Check and required child-safety training.

Position Details

- **Part-time:** 15-20 hours per month, including preparation and coordination
- **Community Meals:** 1st and 3rd Tuesdays, 5:00–7:30 PM
- **Breakfast Church:** One Sunday per month, 9:30 AM–12:00 PM
- **Optional hours:** Sunday morning children's program
- **Compensation:** \$25/hour
- **Commitment:** Six months initially, with the possibility of extension.
