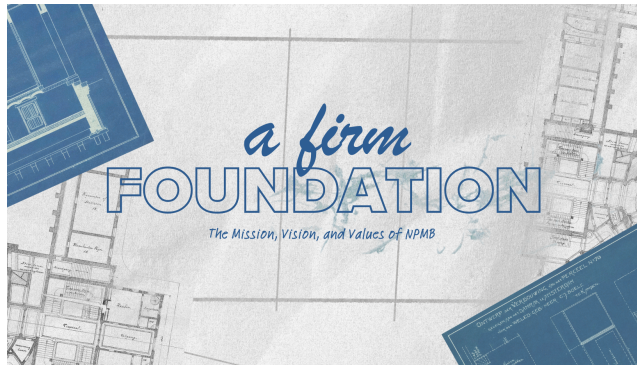




Life Group Study Questions Ephesians 4:11-24

1. Read Ephesians 4:11-24 together. As you think about this weekend's sermon, what stood out to you? What questions come to mind based on the passage? Was there anything unclear or confusing?
2. As you walk through verses 11-16 what are some of the characteristics of spiritual maturity? Which of these characteristics do you struggle most with?
3. What would it look like for someone to "speak the truth in love"? Have you experienced someone doing that for you? What was the result?
4. In verses 17-22, Paul talks about putting off the old self. What are some of the ways of the "old person" you still struggle with? In what ways have you put off the old self? (This is not a time to brag but to celebrate victories you've had because of the Holy Spirit working in you)
5. In verses 23-24, Paul talks about putting on the new self. What does it look like to renew your mind? Talk about ways you practically can do this.
6. As you think about this coming year, what is one or two ways you want to grow in your walk with Jesus? How can this group help one another and hold each other accountable?
