Fall Festival, Chili Cookoff & Pumpkin Carving Message!



My best guess is that I've shared the same Pumpkin Carving sermon on the last weekend of October for the past 10 years. And every fall, I wonder whether I should do it *again*. I ask myself questions like: *"Isn't it getting old? . . . Hasn't everyone heard it about 10 times already? . . . Will people still chuckle at the power saw joke? . . . Is it even OK for a Christian pastor to carve a pumpkin?"*

Every year, I come back to the same reason for sharing the pumpkin carving message: evangelism. My goal is to share Christ—and to encourage people to invite a friend or family member to church. Pumpkin Carving Sunday makes that first invitation feel easy. It's a fresh, creative, and engaging way to share the gospel with someone who may not yet

know Jesus. By the grace of God, we see that happen every year—and so we press on!

We'll also celebrate fall with our annual **Harvest Festival & Chili Cookoff** at church. Although many of us enjoy going for the gold, it's not really about the chili—or the prize. It's about gathering around the table, sharing a meal with glad and sincere hearts, praising God, and enjoying fellowship with one another. *"Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved."* (Acts 2:46–47)

Think of someone you can invite on October 25. Start praying for them—and then take the bold step of asking. A simple, "Would you come with me?" could make all the difference.

Each year, our hope is that Centerpoint's fall activities stay focused on proclaiming Jesus and advancing His Kingdom. When people come to Centerpoint this fall, we pray they'll be encouraged by His people, touched by His Spirit, and moved by His gospel. We hope you'll join us for the Fall Festival and Chili Cookoff—and bring your family, friends, and neighbors—as together we seek to *Love People One Step Closer to Jesus* this October.

Sisterhood: Wherever You Go

We had a wonderful start to our new Sisterhood season! A big thank-you to everyone who made our kickoff such a great night. Thank you to everyone who brought food, helped behind the scenes, or came ready with a hug, a smile, and some encouragement. With a Nor'easter in the forecast, we weren't sure what the evening would look like, but we were so glad to see so many women come out!



This year, we're exploring the theme **"Wherever You Go"** and reflecting on the journeys we take through life and how to discern God's voice along the way. At our kickoff, we explored the story of two disciples walking to Emmaus after Jesus' death and resurrection. They felt discouraged and disappointed because things hadn't gone as they expected. Maybe we can relate.



Sometimes, the journey we're on isn't the one we expected, wanted, planned, or imagined. We face disappointment, doubt, difficult decisions, and uncertainty about where to go next. But as the disciples walked, Jesus came alongside them - even though they didn't recognize Him. He listened, opened the Scriptures, broke bread with them, and helped them see their circumstances differently. When they finally recognized Him, things changed. Their disappointment turned to hope, their confusion to understanding, and they turned around and headed back to Jerusalem.

When we encounter and recognize the risen Jesus, things change.

That doesn't mean every difficult path suddenly becomes easy or that we always understand what God is doing. But we don't walk alone. God meets us on the road, gives us His Word to guide us, and gives us one another to walk alongside us.

That's what we hope to experience together in Sisterhood this year: opportunities to grow in our faith, try new things, build connections, and develop deeper friendships with women we might not normally spend time with.

We may not always know where the road will lead, but we can know who goes with us.

We'll gather again for another large-group Sisterhood evening as we continue our "Wherever You Go" theme with worship, learning, connection, and encouragement.

November 15th, afternoon, "Gather & Go Group"

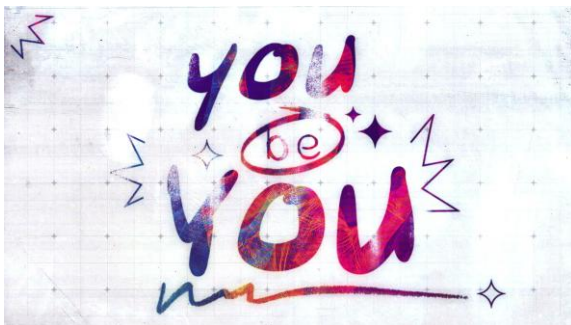
