"We're saved!" the people shouted. They were glad they had trusted God.



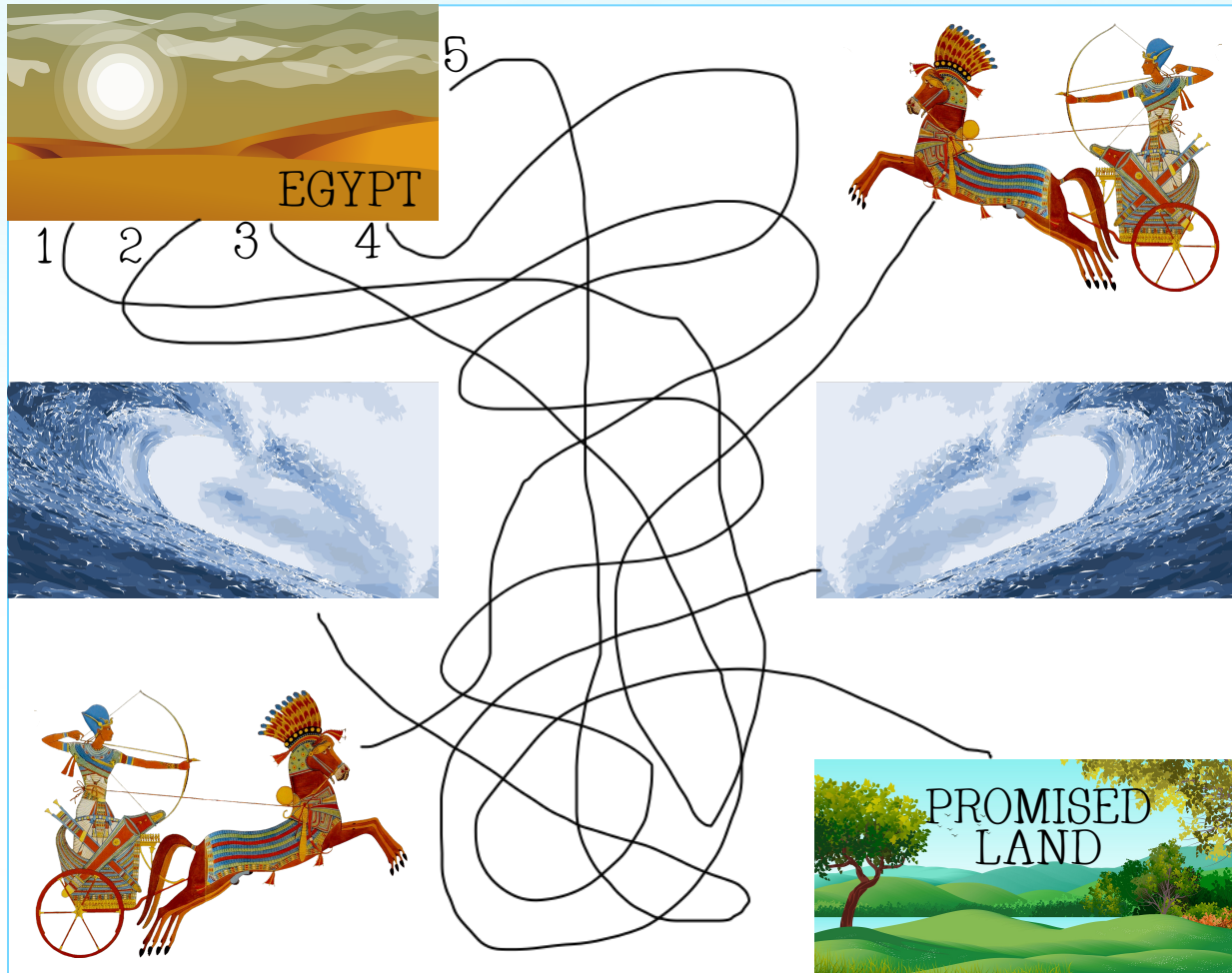
